


Submitting my application


To ensure that my application is processed more quickly, I am filing my two applications in parallel with the CNEDiMTS (HAS) and the ANS.



Evaluation of my application


During the assessment I may be asked to complete the evidence.





Obtaining early repayment

In the event of a favorable decision by the ministers, I obtain the PECAN.



I have read the interoperability and safety guidelines for digital medical devices.

Prerequisites

The solution must be CE marked.

01. I identify the base documentation that concerns me



I have read the interoperability and safety guidelines and all associated documentation.

Consult the documentation on the site of ANS.

02. I'm upgrading my solution



I'm bringing my solution into line with the standards

Point of attention: Updating your digital device may have an impact on your CE marking.

Delay

3 days to open an account

- I create my account on the <u>iSC Identity Provider</u> subsequently allowing me access to the Convergence platform.
- Supporting documents to be provided: Kbis of the company and verification of the identity of the corporate officer on the basis of a valid ID.

Please note: To enroll in a scheme, the representative of your structure must be registered on the Identity Provider as its representative.

Point of attention: To submit a file on Sésame, I must have an access account to the platform. I can request, from HAS, the creation of my account through the <u>corresponding form</u>.

05.a I submit my file to Convergence



I submit my administrative file on the Convergence platform

A certain number of administrative documents will have to be submitted on the Convergence platform.

In particular, don't forget to bring the following documents with you:

- Functional documentation;
- Personal data protection certificate;
- CE marking declaration;
- HDS certificate;

I apply via the HAS Sésame platform

The ministers, in conjunction with the HAS, study the admissibility and completeness of my file. Need help? At any time, I can check the status of my file on Sésame. DÉPÔT ANS 07. My request is validated I will be informed by e-mail about the admissibility of my application DÉPÔT ANS 08. I sign the agreement I receive a signed agreement to return to ANS via the electronic signature tool. Please note: Without this step, the application cannot be successful and does not allow the submission of proofs to verify compliance. **Previous** Next

I submit all my evidence to the ANS

9. I deposit the evidence



I submit ALL proof of compliance via the Convergence platform

I submit evidence of my compliance with the requirements of the Digital Medical Devices (DMN) interoperability and safety guidelines, then respond to requests for additions to my file.

I have the option of **depositing evidence section by section**. If any of the evidence is invalid, I have the option of correcting the evidence or my digital medical device, in order to be compliant.

Point of attention: An application submitted more than 6 months ago but which has not evolved may be considered abandoned.

10. My request is received by the ministers



I receive an acknowledgement of receipt (AR)

If my file is complete both on the Sésame platform and on Convergence (I have submitted all my proofs of conformity), I receive an acknowledgement of receipt (AR) from the ministers in charge of health and social security. This acknowledgement of receipt initiates the official 60-day examination of the file.

Please note:If any information is missing, I receive notification by e-mail.

11.a ANS evaluates my evidence



ANS examines my evidence on the Convergence platform

Delay 60 days

- The NSA has a maximum of 60 days from the date of submission of ALL evidence to evaluate the file. **Please note**: this is not a deadline but an analysis time.
- During this phase, the ANS may contact me via the Convergence platform's internal messaging system if it needs to provide clarification on the evidence.

If the documents supplied are incomplete or do not comply with the requirements



30 days

- I am being solicited by ANS.
- If I do not transmit the requested elements within the allotted time, my registration request is at least deprioritized and in some cases, is deemed abandoned.

Please note:Application processing time will be tracked and time-stamped on the application management tool. Evaluation time on the ANS side is not counted as soon as additional information is pending on the ENS side.

11.b The CNEDiMTS examines my application

EVALUATION CNEDIMTS

My application on the Sésame platform is examined by the CNEDiMTS

Delay

60 days from AR

Please note: The CNEDiMTS issues its opinion within 60 days, upon acknowledgement of receipt of a complete file.

If the parts supplied do not contain all the necessary information

Delay

30 days to complete your application

- I am notified by the ministers in charge of health and social security, where applicable on the proposal of the CNEDiMTS, of the list of additional elements to be provided.
- If I do not send the requested elements within 30 days of receiving the list of required elements, the application is deemed abandoned.

12.a I receive a positive opinion and certification



I receive a favorable opinion from the ANS and obtain the certificate of conformity.

I receive my conformity certification documents by e-mail as well as information for the rest of the conformity certification procedure for digital medical devices.

12.b I receive the notice from CNEDiMTS



I receive a notice from the commission

Delay

60 days

- The commission's opinion is sent to me within 60 days.
- I receive the CNEDiMTS opinion, favorable or unfavorable, via the Sésame platform.

• It is published on the HAS website and also sent to the relevant national professional councils (CNP) if it concerns remote medical monitoring.

13. My application is evaluated



My candidacy is evaluated by the ministers

Delay

30 days from receipt of both notices

On receipt of the last of the two favourable opinions, my application is considered by the ministers responsible for health and social security.

If the parts supplied do not contain all the necessary information

Delay

10 days

- I am notified by e-mail. I must provide the additional information within 10 days.
- If I do not provide the requested information within the allotted time, my registration request is deemed abandoned.

Previous

I obtain early repayment

Prerequisites

I have obtained the favorable opinion of the ministers.

14. I'm eligible for a refund



I'm eligible for early repayment and I'm reimbursed one year before I come under ordinary law.

The decision to reimburse in advance an MND intended for therapeutic purposes or used as part of a remote medical monitoring activity is established by joint order of the ministers in charge of health and social security.

Please note that, following the ministers' decision, I have:

- 6 months to submit my application for coverage on the LLPR.
- 9 months to submit my application for coverage on the LATM.
